

Total Eclipse of the Sun Monday afternoon 21 August 2017 Nashville, TN

On 21 August 2017, the United States will experience an event that last occurred in 1918 – a coast to coast total solar eclipse. From Oregon to South Carolina, the moon will pass between the sun and the earth and turn day into night. This is a once in a lifetime event.

The path of totality runs just 10 miles north of Nashville, TN. At approximately 1:30 PM, people in the path will experience over 2 minutes of total darkness.

The Huntsville Chapter, Military Officers Association of America is sponsoring a bus trip to view the eclipse. This will be a day trip leaving from / returning to Redstone Arsenal and including a stop for lunch.

A 56 seat luxury bus has been reserved. The cost per person will be approximately \$25 (not including lunch) if we have a full bus. Currently there are less than 20 seats remaining.
